

Australian MP Gregory Hunt to visit Singapore on high-level exchange

Australia's Shadow Minister for Climate Change, Environment and Urban Water, Gregory Hunt, is visiting Singapore from April 3 to 11 as the 29th Lee Kuan Yew Exchange Fellow (LKYEF).

According to a statement from the Singapore Foreign Affairs Ministry, Mr Hunt will call on Foreign Affairs Minister George Yeo and Senior Parliamentary Secretary for the Environment and Water Resources Amy Khor during his stay.

Senior Minister of State for National Development Grace Fu will also host him to an official meal.

Mr Hunt will participate in a roundtable discussion at the **S Rajaratnam School of International Studies**. He is also scheduled to attend a People's Action Party (PAP) meet-the-people session.

Mr Hunt's programme in Singapore includes meetings with senior officials at the Ministry of Defence, Ministry of National Development and Ministry of the Environment and Water Resources.

He will also visit the Agency for Science, Technology and Research (A*STAR), Urban Redevelopment Authority's Singapore City Gallery, the NEWater plant, the Marina Barrage, the Changi Chapel Museum and the Night Safari.

Established in 1991, the LKYEF programme invites outstanding individuals for high-level exchange visits to Singapore.

The Fellows are chosen on the basis of their proven track records or extraordinary potential to contribute to the development of their nations, as well as promote international understanding and goodwill.
