


## ENERGY ACCESS AND SUSTAINABILITY



Southeast Asia produced **778 million** tonnes of oil equivalent (MTOE) of energy in 2013, and consumed **606 MTOE**. Looking towards the future, ASEAN is expected to require more than **2.7 times** its current energy production to meet its targeted economic growth.
