Submission Guidelines

As the best essays will be published, the 4,000 word limit includes footnotes and appendices and will be strictly enforced.

- Single authorship only
- Word count – 4,000 words maximum (including footnotes and appendices)
- Include word count on title page of the essay
- Do not include your name on the title page or within the essay but use a pseudonym, which is to appear both on the title page and the entry form
- All previously published essays are ineligible
- Essay is to be submitted as a MS Word document to essay2018@ntu.edu.sg
- Deadline: 1 February 2019
