
CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a contagious disease caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2). The first case was identified in Wuhan, China, in December 2019.

The disease has since spread worldwide, leading to an ongoing pandemic.

Globally, as of 28 March 2021, there have been 126,359,540 confirmed cases of COVID-19, including 2,769,473 deaths, reported to WHO.


CASES IN ASEAN REGION
