




Damage and Destruction to Ukraine's Health Care System, by Month, February 24 to December 31, 2022



In the first week of the conflict, between February 24 and March 2, there were at least 85 reported incidents affecting health care. Between March 1 and 2, there were 42 attacks on health care, where at least 14 hospitals were damaged or destroyed.

Damage and Destruction to Ukraine's Health Care System, by Day, February 24 to December 31, 2022

In the first two weeks of March, there was an average of 10 attacks on Ukrainian health care ever day. 65 of them damaged or destroyed hospitals. Nine health workers were killed and 17 others injured.
